## TANDEM SKYDIVE OVER NOTTINGHAM

Experience the incredible sport of skydiving! Following a short pre-jump briefing, you will enjoy the adrenaline rush of freefall and the thrill of the flight under parachute, all while securely attached to a highly experienced and qualified instructor.

After exiting the aircraft you will freefall for 45 to 50 seconds, reaching speeds of over 120 mph, until your instructor deploys your parachute. The descent under the parachute will take several minutes, during which time you can enjoy the amazing views of the Nottinghamshire countryside.

### ON THE DAY

#### TRAINING

After signing in at reception you will be introduced to one of our experienced tandem instructors. Your instructor will tell you everything you need to know about the equipment, talk you through the aircraft flight, the skydive, and the parachute ride and landing, and will help you practise the required body positions.

#### THE AIRCRAFT FLIGHT

You'll be provided with a skydiving jumpsuit and fitted into your harness. Then you and your instructor will board the aircraft. Once inside the aircraft your instructor will secure your harness to theirs and the aircraft will take off. You'll ride up to altitude in one of our Cessna Grand Caravan aircraft that have been specially

converted for skydiving. During the 20 minute flight you can enjoy the beautiful views of the British countryside.

#### SKYDIVE

When you reach the exit altitude of around 13,500ft you'll begin moving towards the door. The adrenaline kicks in as you and your instructor jump from the aircraft and begin accelerating to terminal velocity. You will reach speeds of over 120mph - it's really noisy and very windy - for around 45 to 50 seconds. At 5,000ft your instructor will deploy the parachute slowing you down for a gentler ride, during which you'll be able to talk to your instructor and even try steering. Your instructor will take control for the landing and you can breathe a sigh of relief when back on solid ground - and tell your cameraman all about it!

#### DEBRIEF

Your instructor will give you time to tell your family and friends about your experience. Once back inside the building you'll be presented with a certificate. If you had the video and photo package you and your spectators will see your skydive on our big screen just a few minutes after your landing.

#### SPONSORSHIP

On registration you will be required to pay a £60 deposit. A minimum sponsorship of £350 is required, this covers your entry fee with all profits directly benefiting the patients of Beaumont House Community Hospice and their families.

Sponsorship will need to be received by the hospice two weeks before the skydive. If we do not receive your sponsorship money by this date you may not be able to take part as we will be unable to pay for your space.

## GIFT AID

If a sponsor is connected to the participant, their donations only qualify for Gift Aid if the participant pays the full cost of the jump so that all the sponsorship money raised goes to the charity.

A 'connected person' is:

- a wife, husband or civil partner
- a brother, sister, parent or grandchild
- the wife, husband or civil partner of a relative
- a company under the control of the donor, or under control of connected persons

## INSURANCE

The cost of your skydive includes provisional membership of the British Parachute Association which provides you with third party liability insurance during your skydive experience. ## VIDEO AND PHOTOS

Skydive Langar offer a Video and Photo package (purchased separately) for an additional £80. One of their experienced freefall photographers will skydive with you and your instructor, taking photos and videos the whole time. The package includes an edited video including footage on the ground, in the plane, in freefall and the parachute landing, along with approximately 20 high quality photos.

## FRIENDS AND FAMILY

The more the merrier! Your friends and family are welcome to come and watch your skydive. There is an onsite cafe for them to get some refreshments and a dedicated viewing area.

## WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS

Weight restrictions apply as follows:

- Those who are 5ft 4" and under have a maximum weight restriction of 13 stone.
- Those who are 5ft 5" and over have a maximum weight restriction of 15 stone.

This limit is in place for your safety and that of Langar Airfield instructions.

You will be required to fill out a medical form prior to your jump, confirming you're able to take part. Please note, if you require a doctor to sign your medical form you may be charged by your surgery. We will supply a letter to you to give to them explaining it is for charity.

## AGE RESTRICTIONS

The minimum age for skydiving is 16. Anyone under 18 requires parental consent.
